## **Bikeability**

Years 4 and 6 have been given the opportunity to take part on the Bikeability course. Year 4 on 22<sup>nd</sup> May and Year 6 on 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> June. If your child is interested in taking part please ensure:-

- Your child has a signed parental consent form.
- Your child can ride a bike unaided.
- Your child must wear a helmet. They are encouraged to wear their own but they will be provided for those who do not have them.
- They have a roadworthy bike. BMX bikes are acceptable as long as they have two working brakes.
- They have a change of clothing appropriate for the weather conditions on the day. Eg. Water proof clothing/socks/trainers/gloves/sunscreen.

All bikes will be checked before the start of the course but it is not the responsibility of the cycling instructors to repair bikes.

The children can come to school on these days dressed ready to cycle.
